

FACTS Individual Member Benefits

Individual Members are expected to support the FACTS mission and vision, and work with us to help us achieve the goals of our organization. Members are asked to abide by the Principles of Dialogue as these are instrumental to fostering relationships and deeper levels of understanding within our organization. Finally, FACTS has developed a statement of principles that outlines our view of fertility and the role of fertility awareness based methods for family planning and reproductive health monitoring.

Professional Level (\$50 per year)

This membership level is ideal for physicians, health care professionals or researchers actively engaged in the practice of medicine, medical education or in FABM academic activity or research. "Professional members" participate and shape the priorities of the collaborative and help carry forth its vision and objectives within health care and medical education.



Associate Level (\$30 per year)

This membership is ideal for community based educators and/or supporters of FABMs, women's health advocates, patients and their partners, and other persons who participate in good faith dialogue about the study, use and applicability of FABMs. "Associate members" provide input and support the activities of FACTS. Within the context of their community setting and with appropriate training, "Associate members" present and discuss content developed by FACTS and provide information about FABMs to others in the community.
